### TO PRAY FOR THE LIVING AND THE DEAD

Jesus told St. Faustina: "I am giving you three ways of exercising mercy toward your neighbor: the first — by deed, the second — by word, the third — by prayer. In these three degrees is contained the fullness of mercy, and it is an unquestionable proof of love for Me. By this means a soul glorifies and pays reverence to My mercy."

Many are often worried because they do not have the material means to carry out a corporal work of mercy which can take much time, talent, or treasure. Yet this spiritual mercy, which requires none of the above, is much more meritorious and is within the grasp of every soul.

Though praying for the living and the dead is easy, accessible to everyone, and can cost a mere moment of your time, it helps you as much or more as it helps those for whom you pray. It draws you closer to God - and you were made for communion with God. You were made to become a son or daughter of God, and prayer is one of the times when that relationship is made most clear. So do yourself a favor:

**Pray** for the living and the dead, the sick and dying.

Pray especially for those least likely to be prayed for, the forgotten, those who are remembered only by heaven.

**Pray** for your friends & your enemies, the enemies of the church, & the enemies of humanity, those most in need of God's mercy.

**Pray** for celebrities in any field of work.

Pray for those who are loved and lost, and those who are loved and found.

**Pray** for the good, the bad, and the lukewarm.

**Pray** for the Holy Spirit to come down upon all the nations, and for all the nations to go up to God.

**Pray** for the change of times and seasons, for the healing of the harm we have done to the earth and to one another.

**Pray** for the impossible to become possible, the irreparable to be made whole, all wrongs to be made right, all right to be made perfect.

Don't forget to pray today, because God didn't forget to wake you up this morning.
